**ZOOM Meetings...**If you are interested in being a part of any of the ZOOM groups, call the church office for more details.

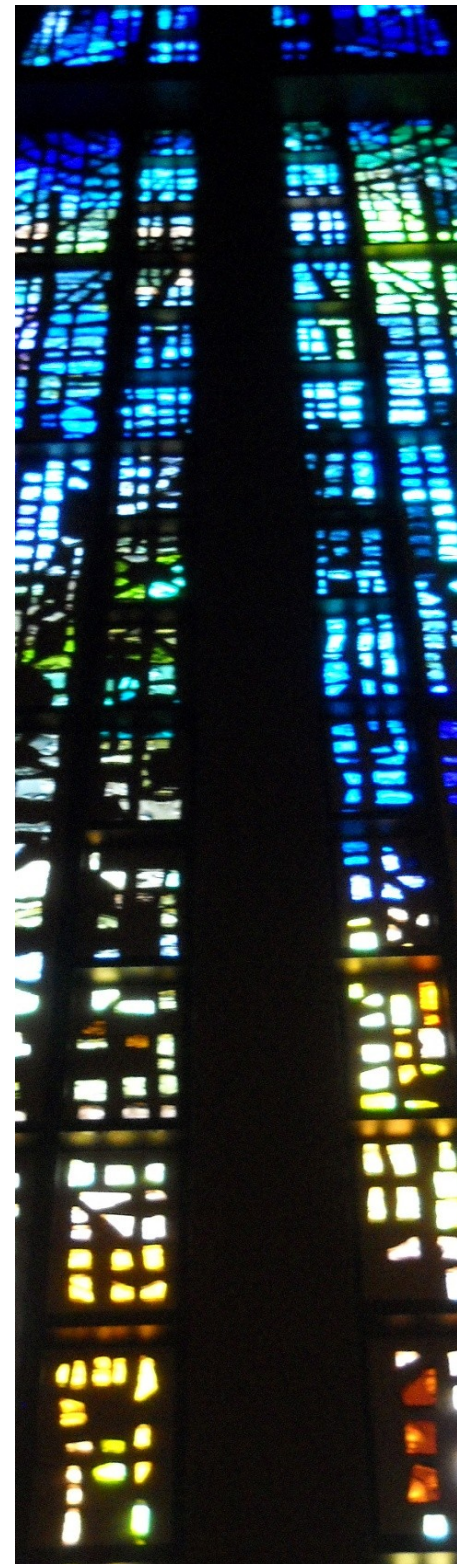
